Conditions of entry

- Entrants must have been bona fide residents of the Northern Territory for not less than 12 months preceding 18 May 2017.
- Entries must be original work of the exhibitor and must have been completed during the 12 months preceding 18 May 2017.
- Entries must not have been previously publicly exhibited within the municipal boundary of the township of Katherine, nor have won any art or other award within the Northern Territory.
- 4. Subject matter must relate to or identify with the NT.
- A maximum of two entries per entrant, in any category, may be submitted. A fee of \$25.00 is required per entry and payment must accompany the completed entry form.
- 6. The entrant shall be responsible for all freight and insurance costs to and from the exhibition.
- Works will be covered by appropriate insurance while housed at Godinymayin Yijard Rivers Arts & Culture Centre.
- 8. Entries must be clearly marked on the back with the title, artist's name and address for the return of work, medium, sale price inclusive of GST and date of completion.
- 9. All entries must be available for sale and a 27.5% commission will be retained on all work sold.
- 10. The award is non acquisitive, however the winning works will be displayed at Godinymayin Yijard Rivers Arts & Culture Centre for three months (unless sold) and then returned to the artists.
- 11. All entrants shall allow their work to be reproduced for promotional purposes.
- 12. Completed entry forms must be received by Godinymayin Yijard Rivers Arts & Culture Centre by Thursday 18 May 2017.
- 13. All work must be delivered to the Godinymayin Yijard Rivers Arts & Culture Centre, Stuart Highway, Katherine East NT 0850 between Tuesday 13 June – Friday 16 June 2017.
- 14. Entries must be packed securely for transit and in a manner suitable for safe re-packing. Any re-packing cost incurred will be charged to the exhibitor.
- The Committee reserves the right to consider, but not necessarily exhibit all works submitted.
- 16. The judge appointed will be the sole arbiter.
- Any conflict arising out of or in connection with the foregoing conditions of entry will be decided by the Committee whose decision shall be final.
- 18. Entries in all categories MUST NOT exceed 1 metre x 1.5 metres in any direction including stands and bases.
- 19. Entry fees WILL NOT be refunded.
- 20. As both awards are aimed at encouraging artists to enter their work in the Katherine Prize, artists who have won the Prize 3 times are not eligible to win again for 5 years after their last winning entry.
- 21. All work must be collected within 7 days of the exhibition finishing on 2 September 2017. Any uncollected work will be disposed of in accordance with the *NT Disposal of Goods Act.*

Materials and framing guidelines

- 1. No works using reproductive technologies will be accepted in the Katherine Prize.
- Craft work must be ready for presentation with any instructions.
- 3. Art work must be professionally presented and submitted with hanging devices.

Any work NOT meeting these criteria may not be accepted.
